All studio information is released through this app. It is the dancer and guardians responsibility to stay up to date with current information on BAND.

TUITION/AUTO-PAY - DANCE STUDIO PRO

Your first month of tuition (September) will be due upon registration. Tuition is due monthly on the 25th of every month to pay for the upcoming month. If payment is not received by the due date a three day grace period is applied, then a \$5 fee will be added to the total tuition for every day the payment is late. If your account continues to be unpaid EDC has the option to dismiss the student from class until the account is current. If a check is returned by the bank a \$15 fee will be charged per returned check. If for some reason you miss a class or a holiday happens to fall on a class date, the full monthly tuition is still required. If schools get out early or canceled due to inclement weather, we will not have class. This is for everyone's safety and the full monthly tuition will still be required.

Signing up for Auto-Pay will ensure your monthly tuition will be on time every month. Auto Pay is run on the 25th of every month for the upcoming month. Auto-pay is only run for

tuition only, all costume fees, recital fees, competition fees, or any other fees will need to be paid separately on your account via online payment, check or cash in the front lobby's tuition box.

ANNUAL RECITAL

Recital will be held in the early summer (May 18, 2023) and there will be one show at 1pm at Seward High School. Recital week is May 13-May 17 and dress rehearsal will be held on May 17. This performance will be held at Seward High School auditorium and is open to all friends, family, and the public. Recital tickets will be pre-sold to dance families on Picture Day (see attached Important Dates sheet) and then will be open to the public to purchase at the door.

A recital fee will be required at \$75 per dancer to perform in recital. This includes a recital tee shirt to wear in the finale performance at recital. Each dancer MUST also have a \$0 balance to practice at the mandatory dress rehearsal the evening before and to perform at the recital.

COSTUMES

A new costume will be purchased each year to wear for the recital. There will be one costume per dance class and one performance per dance class. Costumes range in price from \$80 to \$150 and will be ordered in early December. Payments will be due November 3 (see Important Dates sheet). The costumes MUST be paid in full before they can be ordered.

CLASS GUIDELINES

 Dancers must have ALL accessories that are needed for their dance class for EVERY practice (ie: poms, dance shoes, etc). Any dancer without these requirements will be asked to sit out of class if not prepared.

- All dancers must be wearing the appropriate attire for each dance class. No jeans, dresses, or baggy clothes allowed. Dancers will be asked to sit out of class.
- Dancers must have their hair pulled back tightly and be completely out of their face. Ballet requires a bun WITH a hairnet for all levels of ballet 2 or above.
- Bathrooms must be used before class.
- No cell phones are allowed in the dance rooms during class time.
- We expect our dancers to be respectful of their instructors and classmates. This includes no talking back, eye rolling, not listening and taking corrections, and disrupting class. Treat others as you want to be treated.
- Only CLEAR drinks are allowed in the studio. Water bottles with a lid only please.

PRIVATE LESSONS

Private lessons are upon request. When it's just you and a teacher in the studio, you get all the attention. The teacher can hone in on your weaknesses and design the whole lesson just for you. If you're having a problem with your turns or you want to gain more flexibility, the teacher can tailor the exercises to help strengthen those weaknesses. You don't have to have a specific problem or focus to take private lessons, but it helps to talk to your teacher about your goals and keep an open line of communication. The dancer is able to choose the instructor based on their goals and chosen dance style. Lastly, taking private lessons is very convenient. While group classes are normally scheduled on set days and times, private lessons can be scheduled at a time that is convenient to you and your instructor.

RECITAL SOLOS

Any recreational dancer is encouraged to audition. Recital solo audition videos will be due on January 20th. Three soloists will be chosen each season to perform their solo at recital. The solos can be in many styles, lyrical, tap, hip hop, clogging, jazz, etc. Each dancer who receives a solo will be given what style they will be performing in. A solo fee of \$375 is still required for the dancers chosen as soloists. Please plan to purchase a costume for solos. *These solos are separate from ballet solo auditions*.

CLASS CANCELLATIONS/STUDIO CLOSING

We follow Milford Public School closings. If Milford Public Schools get let out early or canceled due to inclement weather, we will NOT have classes.
